Dickenson started at quarterback as a junior and senior for CMR. He earned first team All-State and Offensive MVP both seasons. His football jersey (#15) has been retired by the school. He also started for the Rustlers basketball team as a junior and senior and was an All-State golfer. He attended the University of Montana. Dickenson started as a sophomore leading Montana to the 1993 NCAA Division I-AA playoffs. As a junior, he led UM to the national semi-finals. In 1995, he quarterbacked the Grizzlies to the I-AA national championship. This same year he won the Walter Payton Award as the most valuable player in NCAA 1-AA football. He went on to have a very successful career in the Canadian Football League where in 2000 he was named the CFL's most outstanding player.
