Parsons played three sports, and earned All-State honors in football and basketball as well as being the high-point performer at the state track meet both his junior and senior seasons for Helena High School. In football he was named All-State in 1939 and 1940 the same two years he won All-State honors in basketball. Parsons was the state meet's top scorer as a senior. Parsons went on to play football for Santa Ana Junior College in California for two seasons. He then transferred to the University of Southern California where he helped the Trojans to victory in the 1944 Rose Bowl. Parsons was drafted by the Philadelphia Eagles, played for the Los Angeles Bulldogs and then played two seasons for the San Francisco 49ers of the National Football League.
