Brown lettered three years in football, two years in basketball and four years in track at Red Lodge High School. He was the Class B state champion in the mile run for three years. As a senior, Brown set a record with a run of 4:16.5. Brown was one of the nation's outstanding prep grads invited to the Golden West Invitational Meet in Los Angeles. He won the fastest prep two-mile ever, 9:16.2. Also, while running for the Grizzlies he was a five-time All-American in cross-country and track. He was the NCAA champion and record holder in both the 3-mile and 6-mile runs in 1965.
