Cate was selected All-State her sophomore, junior and senior years and took home the most valuable player award for each of her team's three state championships in basketball for Billings Central. She was an All-State selection all four years of her high school career. In volleyball, Cate led the Rams to back-to-back Class A championships and was named most valuable player at the state volleyball tournament. During her three years, she was selected to the All-State volleyball team each year. Cate attended the University of Montana. She was named to the Kodak First Team All-America team and set the Big Sky career scoring record for men and women, with 2,172 points. In 1991, she was named the AAU Little Sullivan Award winner as the best athlete in Montana. She set 14 records at UM.
