

MFEA Scholarship Application: General Guidelines

Eligibility:

- a) Applicant must be a graduating senior and a current competitor in Montana Forensics.
- b) The student applicant must have competed for 3 years.
- c) Scholarship will be awarded for the second term of student's freshman year in college/technical school and is contingent upon completion of a 2.5 collegiate GPA for the first term.

Application Process:

- a) Cover sheet including: student name, High School, Coaches' name, events/years
- b) Two letters of recommendation, one of which comes from your speech, debate, or drama coach.
- c) Include a current transcript from your High School.
- d) Provide a letter of intent (maximum of 1 typed page, 12-pt Times or Arial, double-spaced, 1" margins). This letter should answer the following question: How will the skills you acquired in Speech, Debate and Drama benefit you in your future career?
- e) Provide an educational resume including: GPA and grading scale; a list of honors, activities, community service or volunteer work; job experience which may be applicable; and an account of Forensics achievements.

Selection Criteria:

- a) Application is on-time
- b) All materials are complete
- c) Applicant meets all criteria
- d) Awards will be determined from acceptable applications at the discretion of the standing Forensics Scholarship Committee.

Award Procedures:

- a) A maximum of 5 scholarships will be awarded per year
- b) Awards will range from \$100 to \$300
- c) It is the recipient's responsibility to forward their first term transcript and a current mailing address to the committee by February 1st, 2009, in order to receive the awarded amount.
